**WHEREAS**, the City of Dothan received 2020 Municipal Water Pollution Prevention (MWPP) Program Annual Report forms from the AL Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) to be completed for the City's three (3) wastewater treatment plants (WWTPs) and their collection systems by May 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dothan Utilities Wastewater Treatment Division has completed the 2019 MWPP Annual Reports for the Cypress Creek (Permit No. AL0072737), Little Choctawhatchee (Permit No. AL0047465), and Omussee Creek (Permit No. AL0022764) WWTPs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Dothan has reviewed said Annual MWPP Reports and continue to implement the following actions to prevent effluent violations:

Little Choctawhatchee WWTP-Municipality Action Range with Sanitary Sewer Overflow Events and Wastewater Treatment Plant Flows during three large storm events being the primary contributing factor for point values. The City will continue to adhere to the Administrative Order on Consent with EPA to develop and implement programs designed to reduce and eliminate sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) events by authorization of Resolution No. 2012-172 on July 17, 2012. Over flow events action taken include: Authorization by Resolution 2021-85 for professional services agreement to design, bid and construction phases services for the Beaver Creek Trunk Line, authorization by Resolution 2021-66 for additional appropriations to be funded during the Mid-Biennium Budget for Basin B4-52 Sewer Repair and Rehabilitation per AOC, Baywood Lift Station Elimination, Indian Hills Lift Station Elimination.

Cypress Creek WWTP-Actions As Appropriate with the following contributing point values: Age of Facility, Overflow Events and Wastewater Treatment Plant Flows during three large storm events being the primary contributing factor for point values. The City will continue to adhere to the Administrative Order on Consent with EPA to develop and implement programs designed to reduce and eliminate sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) events by authorization of Resolution No. 2012-172 on July 17, 2012. The City will continue strategic planning of improvements to the Cypress Creek WWTP as identified in the City of Dothan Community Investment Program.

Omussee Creek WWTP- Actions As Appropriate with Sanitary Sewer Overflow Events and Wastewater Treatment Plant Flows during three large storm events being the primary contributing factor for point values. The City will continue to adhere to the Administrative Order on Consent with EPA to develop and implement programs designed to reduce and eliminate sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) events by authorization of Resolution No. 2012-172 on July 17, 2012.
