

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is the leading cause of death in the United States claiming more than 300,000 lives annually; and

WHEREAS, ninety-five percent of SCA victims die before they reach a hospital or receive medical attention. Once a person experiences SCA, he or she has about five minutes to receive an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) shock to reset the heart's rhythm. Without the AED shock, the chance of surviving decreases by ten percent every minute life saving measures such as hands-only CPR are not initiated; and

WHEREAS, June 1-7 is National CPR and AED Awareness Week. The Southeast Health Foundation is leading a community-wide initiative to develop a HeartSafe program for the region. The Foundation has partnered with the City of Dothan, Dothan Fire Department and Dothan Area Chamber of Commerce to reduce the number of deaths from SCA. To become the first HeartSafe community in Alabama, we are encouraging organizations to make sure they have an adequate number of AEDs and their employees are trained in hands-only CPR.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark Saliba, Mayor of the City of Dothan, and in such capacity, do hereby proclaim June 1-7, 2022, as

"CPR AND AED AWARENESS WEEK"

in the City of Dothan and call upon our citizens to observe this week with appropriate programs and activities to increase awareness of factors and symptoms of SCA.
