NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON APRIL 15, 2008

The City of Dothan will conduct a public meeting Tuesday April 15 at 6:00 p.m. at the Dothan Opera House 115 N. Saint Andrews Street to discuss the 201 Wastewater Facilities Plan Update for Basin III of the Dothan Sewer System and improvements to the Dothan Sewer System recommended therein. These improvements consist primarily of the decommissioning of the city's existing Beaver Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility, construction of approximately four miles of 48" gravity transfer sewer extending from the existing Beaver Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility to the existing Little Choctawhatchee Wastewater Treatment Facility and the expansion and upgrade of the Little Choctawhatchee Wastewater Treatment Facility.

The construction cost of the project is expected to be approximately \$46 million to be financed using low interest loans from the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Program administered by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management. The use of this type of loan requires that the City of Dothan conduct a public meeting with 30 days notification to its citizens. This meeting will take the place of Commissioner Keith Seagle's previously scheduled question and answer session for March 18, 2008.

Information will be presented at this meeting concerning alternatives to the proposed action, environmental impacts and other considerations relating to the project.

The facility plan update may be examined at the office of the Manager of Dothan Utilities, 200 Kilgore Dr., Dothan, Alabama during normal business hours.
