NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Dothan, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Dothan accepts funding from the United States Secret Service (USSS) for participation in the U.S. Secret Service Alabama Electronic Crimes Task Force for reimbursement of equipment totaling \$2,006.91.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2007 be appropriated in FY 2021 to the General Fund/Police Department/Criminal Investigation/Public Safety/Materials & Supplies/Other Operating Supplies, Account Number 001-1204-512.20-29, Project #ALECTF, Grant #USSS AL-ECTF, for equipment. This appropriation is to be funded by increasing the General Fund/Intergovernmental Revenue/Grant Revenues/FBI-Violet Crime Task Force, Account Number 001-0000-331.04-00 by the sum of \$2,007 in FY 2021.


Dear Chief Parish,

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Joint Operations Budget has been approved. The Dothan Police Department has been allocated a total of \$2,006.91 from the U.S. Secret Service's Birmingham Cyber Fraud Task Force (BCFTF).

These funds can be used for overtime, training, certifications, or purchases of equipment for the task force member. The reimbursement procedure is the same as last year. Once the aforementioned funds are spent by your department, all receipts must be presented to the BCFTF by July 31, 2021 in order to facilitate reimbursement. These funds must be used by the Detective(s) assigned to the Birmingham Field Office's BCFTF; this is required by the U.S. Treasury Department. **These funds are not to be put into the department's general funds.**
