

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - \_\_\_\_\_

**WHEREAS**, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) from past years can be reprogrammed by local amendment according to the guidelines contained in the current Consolidated Plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dothan, Alabama desires to reprogram a total of \$173,387.22 in un-obligated CDBG Entitlement funds from cost under runs or from completed or canceled projects in the following program years:

- (1) **Program Year 2013 totaling \$11,549.17**, including remaining amounts from the following completed projects: Neighborhood Restoration Corp. emergency home repair (\$7,884); Wiregrass Rehab Center, purchase assistance for shredding machines (\$549); Alfred Saliba Family Services, improvements to the program office at Young Junior Building (\$495); Boys & Girls Club of Wiregrass for siding improvements (\$1,843.17); and Catholic Social Services for purchase assistance for a food freezer (\$778).
- (2) **Program Year 2014 totaling \$12,933.83**, including remaining amounts from the following completed projects: Dothan Downtown Redevelopment Authority Façade Improvement project (\$10,342.97); Legal Services Alabama (\$254.56); Boys & Girls Club of Wiregrass for HVAC improvements (\$1,881); Hawk-Houston Boys & Girls Club for HVAC improvements (\$76); and Wiregrass Rehabilitation Center for equipment purchase (\$379.30).
- (3) **Program Year 2018 totaling \$28,904.22** from the remaining unused amount of funds designated for the extension of a sidewalk along Alexander St.
- (4) **Program Year 2019 totaling \$120,000** from the canceled Third Avenue sidewalk installation project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is proposing to amend its 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and its 2020 and 2021 Annual Action Plans to include the following proposed uses of prior year, un-obligated CDBG Entitlement funds:

- (1) **Dothan Downtown Redevelopment Authority Façade Improvement Program (PY 2020)**. CDBG funding of \$10,342.97 to continue to assist business owners with facade grants to improve the appearance of downtown Dothan.
- (2) **Habitat for Humanity Weatherization Program (PY 2020)**. Additional CDBG funding of \$14,140.03 to be used to provide home weatherization for low- and moderate-income homeowners.
- (3) **City of Dothan – Moss Street Improvements (PY 2021)**. CDBG funding of \$146,704.22 to be used to make street improvements along Moss Street between Streyer and Reid Streets.
- (4) **Dothan Fire Department – Stovetop Firestop Program (PY 2021)**. Additional CDBG funds of \$2,200 to be used to provide fire safety education to residents of the Dothan Housing Authority. The Fire Department will provide one-on-one fire safety training to residents when installing stovetop firestop canisters in the kitchen of Housing Authority units, as well as classroom training to residents on fire safety at the Housing Authority's meeting room; and

**WHEREAS**, these actions can be accomplished through a local amendment and is within the guidelines for a local amendment contained in the current Consolidated Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Dothan, Alabama, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the City of Dothan, by action of the City Commission, hereby approves the following 2020 and 2021 projects to be funded using \$173,387.22 in un-obligated CDBG Entitlement funds from cost under runs or from completed or canceled projects in the 2013, 2014, 2018, and 2019 Program Years:

**SECTION 2.** That the City of Dothan, by action of the City Commission, following required public notice and public hearing, does hereby approve and adopt the reprogramming of prior year CDBG funds for the 2020 and 2021 CDBG projects.

**SECTION 3.** That Mark Saliba, Mayor of the City of Dothan and in such capacity, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all required documents related to requirements of the 2021 Annual Action Plan and submit same to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
