

## **MANDATORY TREATMENT ACT 1990**

### **CRO (COURT REFERRAL OFFICE)**

You have been ordered by the Judge, District Attorney, or Probation Officer in your case to be evaluated by a Court Referral Officer (CRO). The primary goal of the court referral is to place you in the most appropriate program which will assist you in making more responsible decisions about your drinking and/or drug use in the future. The court Referral Officer is responsible for your evaluations, referral for appropriate program and monitoring.

### **YOUR COMPLETE COOPERATION IS EXPECTED AND ANY NON-COMPLIANCE WITH RECOMMENDATIONS WILL BE REPORTED BACK TO THE COURT**

There is a \$100 fee for the evaluation, payable on the day of your evaluation appointment. There is a \$10.00 charge for failure to show for an appointment or for rescheduling the same day of your appointment.

- Pay ALL fees. No Personal Checks are accepted.
- If you are unable to attend a session for any reason, you must notify the CRO office.
- The use of alcohol or other drugs is not allowed during the entire time you are participating in the CRO program.
- This program is conducted in compliance with the Alabama Law at the direction of the Court.
- Inappropriate Behavior will not be Tolerated

Please Note: ALL appointments with CRO (court referral officer) are **mandatory**. If you fail to attend this appointment, your case will be referred back to the court for sentencing or further action.
