

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-164

WHEREAS, Section 11-46-27 of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended, provides, in part, that the municipal governing body, not less than 15 days before the holding of any municipal election, appoint from the qualified electors of the municipality, officers to hold the elections.

WHEREAS, Section 11-46-27(h) of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended, provides for the municipal governing body to establish compensation.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.




Associate Commissioner District 1



Associate Commissioner District 2




