

Trail Rules

1	If gate is locked the trail is closed. When trails are closed they are closed to all users – violators will be prosecuted
2	For trail status visit www.dothanleisureservices.org and click the link for the Southeast Alabama Mountainbikers Facebook page
3	It is recommended that everyone wears a protective bicycle helmet of good fit when engaged in riding the trails, state law requires the bicycle operator or passenger under the age of 16 must wear a protective helmet of good fit and be fastened securely upon the head.
4	Cell phones strongly recommended – in case of emergency dial 911
5	Take adequate hydration
6	Leave no trace
7	Earphones of any type are discouraged on the trail “you are responsible for your ability to hear other trail users”
8	This is a shared trail – ride and hike responsibly
9	Wildlife in their natural habitat can present hazards – use caution
10	Do not use or make shortcuts
11	Unauthorized trail work or modifications are strictly prohibited
12	Dogs must be on a 6ft leash
13	No motorized vehicles or horses allowed on trails
14	No hunting or fishing allowed on property
15	Visitors should be aware that this tract is subject to 220-4-.15 regulations of certain conduct
16	Alcohol is prohibited
