STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE – NO. 32
POLICIES ON CAMPAIGNING ON CITY PROPERTY

I. PURPOSE

To establish procedures concerning campaigning and campaign signs on City property.

II. GUIDELINE

- a. No campaigning or campaign signs are allowed on City property. Campaign signs are to be removed from City property by City of Dothan Code Enforcement personnel and stored at the Police Department (for a period of seven days) for candidates to retrieve.
- b. Vehicles displaying political paraphernalia are not to be parked on City property. Violators will be reported to the Police Department. If the political candidate drives the vehicle to an event as his/her mode of transportation, that is acceptable.
- c. Political candidates are not to pass out literature at Leisure Services functions held on City property. This is a courtesy for our patrons, so they are not inconvenienced while attending our events.


III. RESERVATION OF AUTHORITY
