Southeast Health Foundation is hosting HeartSafe "Press the Chest" CPR training events at several locations throughout the Wiregrass as part of National CPR and AED Awareness Week, which is June 1st - June 7th.

The Dothan Fire Department and Southeast Alabama Emergency Medical Services held free hands-only CPR and AED training classes for City of Dothan employees on June 1st at Westgate Recreation Center and the Wiregrass Public Safety Center. 110 city employees participated in the training as part of the City of Dothan's commitment to become a more heart-friendly place to work and live. Dothan Leisure Services is furthering CPR and AED education by holding training sessions on June 2nd for all summer camp counselors before camps begin next week.
